No matter which method you choose, you'll be guided through the history of Louisville's bourbon heritage and the world's most celebrated bourbon bars. Just drink in the atmosphere, or enjoy a bite to eat. Be sure to ask your bartender or server to validate your passport (or app) before you leave.

Collect a stamp from six different stops along the Urban Bourbon Trail and you'll earn the rank of official Bourbon Country Citizen. You'll also be awarded a special Urban Bourbon Trailblazer t-shirt and official Citizen of Bourbon Country certificate, so you can proudly display your passion for bourbon to the world.
